6. Your participation is voluntary only, there is no remuneration for your attendance.
7. You will receive a digital copy of your portrait upon the completion of the project.
8. Participants under 18 years old must have signed consent by guardian.
9. Photography and artwork style is at the discretion of the artist and cannot be altered.
10. Images are the intellectual property of the artist and cannot be sold or reproduced externally. Whitehorse Council has the right to reproduce the images as part of the project promotions only.
11. By participating in this event you are consenting to the use of your image to be used in Whitehorse Council promotions as part of the Lunar New Year celebrations.

Personal information including a participant's name, address, telephone number and email will be collected and used by Council for the purpose of this project and for Council's promotion purposes including on the wbiz.com.au website and across its media/communication platforms at its discretion.
