Dear Resident or Business Owner/Operator,

Weekly Works Alert – week commencing 25 July 2022

We're removing the dangerous and congested level crossings at Union Road, Surrey Hills and Mont Albert Road, Mont Albert by lowering the rail line beneath the road in an open trench and building a new premium station with better facilities and more services.

Works taking place from Monday 25 July:

Traffic management and detours will be in place on Union Road, Mont Albert Road and local streets to assist with vehicle and pedestrian movements. Pedestrian access will be maintained around our sites.

Union Road		
Activity	Date	What to expect
Road closure	Continuing until 15 August	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Road closure between Croydon Road and Windsor Crescent for bridge works. Activities will take place day and night to minimise the duration of the road closure. Access to the Coles Local basement carpark is available via the laneway off Croydon Road.

Mont Albert Road		
Activity	Date	What to expect
Road closure	Continuing until 25 July	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mont Albert Road will re-open on Monday 25 July. Some trimming of low hanging branches may be required on Mont Albert Road to facilitate movement of machinery to and from site.
Lane closure	Commencing 1 August until 28 August	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The eastbound lane of Mont Albert Road will be closed day and night between Leopold Crescent and Gordon Street from Monday 1 August to Sunday 28 August. Works will take place day and night during this time.

Churchill Street		
Activity	Date	What to expect
Temporary lane and road closures	Continuing until October	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The temporary lane closure will remain in place on Churchill Street between Mont Albert Station and Box Place. The eastbound lane will be reopened on Churchill Street between Box Place and Elgar Road in August. Temporary road closures will be in place while concrete barriers are removed.
Piling	Commencing early August	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Piling works will begin in Churchill Street in early August and continue through to September. The first stage of this work will take place between Salisbury Avenue and Box Place.

Beresford Street (north of Mont Albert Road)		
Activity	Date	What to expect
Watermain relocation works	Commencing 26 July until 6 August	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Excavation and service investigation work to relocate the watermain will continue on Beresford Street at the corner of Mont Albert Road and Beresford St. Vehicle access to Beresford Street will be available via High Street.

Beresford Street (south of Mont Albert Road)		
Activity	Date	What to expect
Piling	Ongoing until August 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Piling (installing vertical concrete columns) for the trench walls will continue on Beresford Street. Beresford Street will remain closed between Wilson Street and Mont Albert Road. Some on-street parking will be temporarily unavailable on Montrose Street during construction hours for the safe passage of machinery to the work site.
Watermain relocation works	Ongoing until late 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Works on the new watermain under the rail corridor will continue with pipe installation now that Dora the Bora has completed her journey. During this time the intersection of Montrose Street, Wilson Street and Beresford Street will remain closed.

Lorne Parade		
Activity	Date	What to expect
Stormwater drainage relocation works	Ongoing until late July	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> New stormwater drainage works will continue along Lorne Parade involving excavation, trenching and pipe installation. Traffic management and a temporary closure of on-street parking and driveway access will be in place for some properties. Impacted properties have been notified separately. Water bypass to maintain your water supply is in place until this work is complete.
Watermain renewal works	Ongoing from 25 July	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Excavation work to restore the watermain will be carried out for approximately 2 weeks. Driveway access will be maintained between 4 and 18 Lorne Parade however some minor delays may be expected.
Trenching works	Commencing from 25 July	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Excavation and trenching works will be carried out between Lorne Parade Reserve to 8 Lorne Parade for approximately one week to install a new Telstra pit.
Road closure and power outage	Commencing from 27 July	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A temporary road closure will be required between Windsor Crescent and 8 Lorne Parade to deliver a large power pole into Lorne Parade Reserve. A power outage will be in place on 27 July between 8am and 4pm while <i>United Energy</i> and their contractors install a new power pole in the reserve. Impacted properties on Lorne Parade will be notified by the service provider <i>United Energy</i>.

Windsor Crescent		
Activity	Date	What to expect
Movement of machinery	Continuing until 2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lane closures and traffic management may be required for movement of machinery to and from site.

Sunbury Crescent		
Activity	Date	What to expect
Sewer, drainage and watermain relocation works	Continuing until late 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Localised road closures on Sunbury Crescent. • Some on-street parking closures. • Driveway access will be temporarily impacted for some properties.

Robinson Road		
Activity	Date	What to expect
Road closure	Continuing until 15 August	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Road closure between Canterbury Road and Sunbury Crescent, detours in place.

Stirling Crescent		
Activity	Date	What to expect
Sewer relocation works	Continuing until September 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A staged road closure will remain in place as sewer relocation works progress. • Driveway access will be temporarily impacted for some properties and affected stakeholders will be contacted separately. • Access to Stirling Crescent will be via laneway entrance behind the Harmony Market. Access to the area will change as works progress, affected stakeholders will be kept up to date.

Surrey Park		
Activity	Date	What to expect
Truck movements and 24/7 access	Continuing until Monday 15 August	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trucks and machinery will be entering and exiting the Surrey Park storage site throughout July, including during 24/7 works.

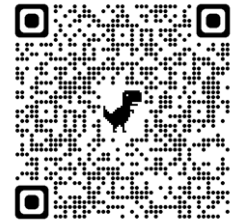
We are currently undertaking major works to install the foundations for the bridges at Union Road and Mont Albert Road and relocating underground services.
