Dear Resident or Business Owner/Operator,

Works alert – Mont Albert power works

We're removing the dangerous and congested level crossings at Union Road, Surrey Hills and Mont Albert Road, Mont Albert by lowering the rail line beneath the roads in an open trench and building a new premium station with better facilities and more services.

Works taking place

On **Tuesday 4 October**, there will be a power outage associated with power relocation and upgrade works in Mont Albert. Works will be undertaken by the service authority **United Energy** and their contractors.

United Energy will provide you with further details, including information about any interruption to the power supply and how to contact them if you have further queries about their works.

What to expect

The planned power outage will take place between **8am and 6pm** for up to **10 hours** on **Tuesday 4 October**. During this time Lorne Parade will be **closed to traffic**, including driveway access from **7am to 6pm** to provide safe access to utility assets. This closure will be in place for one day only during work hours.

To complete the works safely we will need to temporarily close the on-street parking in front of **329 - 333 Mont Albert Road**.

Other impacts of these works include:

- Construction noise and activity, with vehicles, machinery and workers on Lorne Parade and Mont Albert Road
- Pedestrian access will be maintained with some minor detours in place
- Traffic management to keep you and our workers safe.

Further information will be provided by United Energy to impacted properties prior to work commencing.

Please be aware that works can sometimes take longer than expected due to weather and other factors outside of our control. You can stay up to date with our works by following the instructions below.

Planning for the Interruption

We encourage you to plan ahead, as this disruption may have an impact on the way you go about your daily activities, ability to work and/or complete school requirements from home.

If you will have difficulty managing the interruption to your power supply and feel your circumstance requires special consideration, please contact our team on 1800 105 105 to discuss assistance options we may be able to offer you.
