Burwood

As part of Suburban Rail Loop East (SRL East), we are undertaking site investigations in Burwood. This work will commence in late September and will take approximately two weeks to complete, ground conditions and weather permitting.

SRL will transform Victoria's public transport network and enhance the communities it connects.

SRL East from Cheltenham to Box Hill will link major employment, health, education and retail destinations in Melbourne's east and south east.

The new underground train line will reduce travel times and create up to 8000 direct local jobs during delivery.

The new station at Burwood will be located adjacent to Deakin University, improving connections to existing tram and bus services, and providing a new rail connection for local workers, students, and residents.

The new station at Burwood will deliver a train line to the doorstep of one of Australia's biggest universities for thousands of staff and students, and better connect locals to key destinations across Melbourne.

What are site investigations

Site investigations help the project team better understand important information about the underlying ground conditions and where utilities and services are located. This data informs the project's design, planning, and construction methods.

What we are doing

We will be undertaking site investigations in the Lundgren Chain Reserve Playground off Highbury Road to locate utility services and conduct soil sampling.

These activities are required as part of investigative works ahead of construction of a new, temporary park in Burwood near the Lundgren Chain Reserve.

How we will manage our work

The project team may use equipment that generates dust and medium levels of noise. Measures will be put in place to minimise impacts to the surrounding community.

These may include:

- Positioning equipment as far as possible from businesses and homes and turning it off when not in use
- Applying water during cutting and drilling if required
- Monitoring noise levels.

When

Site investigations will take place for approximately two weeks from **Tuesday 27 September**. Works will be completed during normal working hours.

Normal day-time working hours

7am - 6pm, Monday to Friday

7am - 1pm, Saturdays

What to be aware of

There will be periods of medium levels of noise from equipment during these works.

There will also be some on-street car space and lane closures. However, pedestrian and vehicle access will be maintained to all properties and around work zones at the reserve. Traffic impacts are shown on the map below.

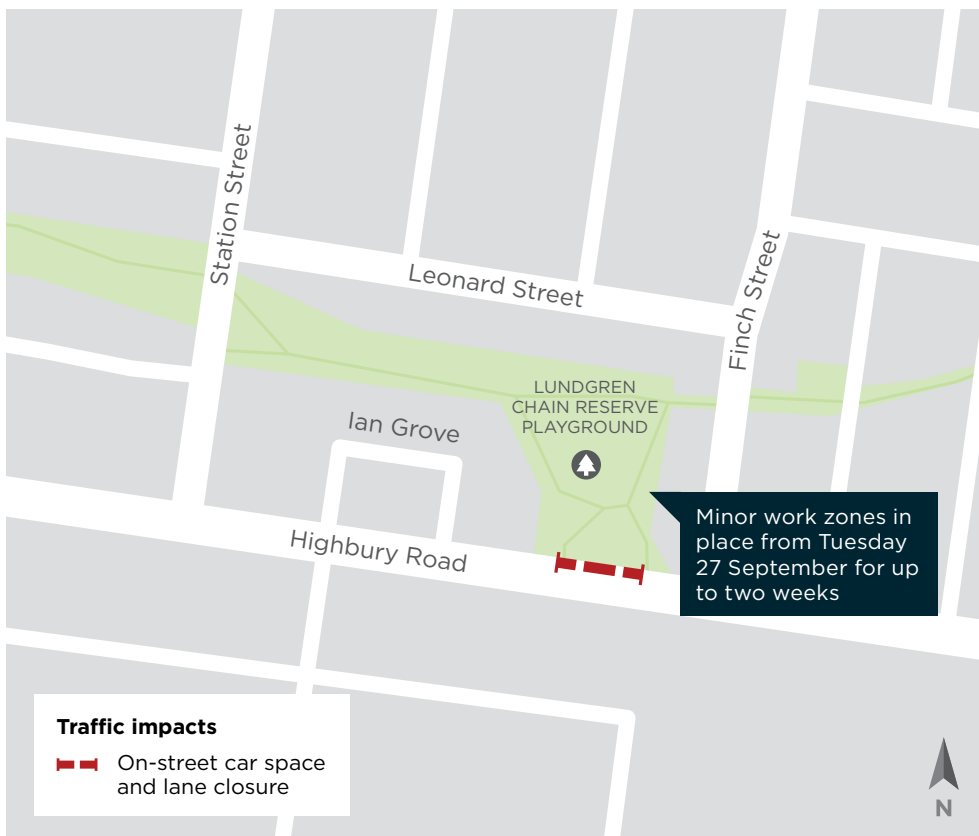
