Household bins

Council provides weekly garbage and fortnightly recycling bin collections. The Food Organics and Garden Organics (FOGO) bin is an optional user-pays fortnightly collection.

140L or 240L


Council offers different bin sizes to suit your needs:

- A standard service includes one 80 litre red-lid garbage bin and one 240 litre yellow-lid recycling bin.


Ensure your bins are put out correctly.



Correct bin placement

- Place bins side by side leaving **at least 50cm between bins** and **keep clear of obstructions** (poles, trees, overhead wires etc.).
- Bins should be placed **at least 1m clear from cars** next to the kerb, with **handles facing away from the road**.


Place your bins correctly for your street type:



Dead end
Place all bins on one side of your street.



Court bowl
Do not place your bin in the court bowl end of your street.



Hammerhead
Do not place your bin in the corners of the hammerhead of your street.

No overfilled bins

- Do not place rubbish on or next to your bin, these will not be collected.
- Do not overfill your bin, the lids must close.
- The maximum weight for all bins is **70kg**.



Be on time

Place bins out **the night before** collection day. Once collected, return them back to your property within 24 hours.

Newspapers, magazines, phone books & office paper



Cardboard

Flatten boxes to save space in your bin



Glass jars & bottles

Lids & labels left on



Aluminium & steel

Empty aerosols, foil, cans & trays



Plastic bottles & containers

Hard, rigid plastic bottles and containers from the kitchen, bathroom and laundry with their lids and labels left on

Recycling tips:

- Empty contents of items before placing them in the bin – no need to rinse.
- Squash bulky containers down to save space.



- If you are unsure if something can be recycled, visit our website or download the **Recycle Mate** app.

Your recycling is sorted at a facility and sent off to be recycled into new products.



Keep your recycling loose
Don't put items in plastic bags.

Lime green compostable liners

Liners must be coloured lime green and have the Australian Standard 4736 and seedling logo.



Takeaway & leftovers



Human & animal hair



Small amounts of paper towels, shredded paper, napkins, tissues, and food soiled paper

When you run out of liners, you can:

- Pick up a roll from customer service (limits apply).
- Use paper towel or newspaper to line your caddy.
- Place items loose in your caddy (rinse regularly).
- Purchase compostable lime green liners from selected supermarkets, garden supply stores or online suppliers.



FOGO materials are turned into compost for gardens and farms. Please ensure the correct materials go in the bin.

Eligible households can receive a 140 or 240 litre bin, and are provided with a kitchen caddy, roll of compostable liners and info pack to get started.



If you live in a unit or apartment block of six or more dwellings, please get in touch with your property manager to organise your collection.

Council provides two free hard waste collections each financial year. Additional bookings are available at a cost.

Book your collection

- Visit whitehorse.vic.gov.au/hard-waste
- Call our service provider on 9780 6120

Bookings close at 5pm on Wednesday for collection the following week. This may be longer in busy times.

- Bookings will be confirmed by email and/or SMS informing you of your collection week.
- Once your booking has been confirmed you will be mailed out an information pack with an orange '**BOOKED**' sticker.
- Place the '**BOOKED**' sticker on an item that is unlikely to be taken by someone else and can be clearly seen from the road.

Neatly present your collection

Place accepted items on the nature strip no earlier than the weekend before, and no later than 6am on the Monday of your collection week.

- Please ensure your booking is within the correct size limits.
- Where only a single booking is made, excess items will be counted as two collections.
- Items should be no heavier than 55kgs and no longer/wider than 2 metres (smaller limits apply for certain items).
- Unaccepted items will not be collected.

! Excess waste or items placed on the nature strip without a booking is considered illegal dumping and may result in a fine



Mattresses & bed bases

Maximum two items per collection



Carpet Maximum of 1 roll, no wider than 1.5m and able to be carried by 1 person



Timber No longer than 1.5m and no more than 10 pieces



Scrap metal & car parts

Small items only



Lawn mowers



Branches & prunings

Up to 7.5cm in diameter and no longer than 1.5m. Bundled and tied with string or twine and no wider than 30cm



Polystyrene

Solid polystyrene or plastic foam packaging (no beans, balls, etc.) securely bagged, boxed or tied and weighted down



Broken glass & crockery

Glass items, ceramics and crockery (wrapped and labelled 'glass' or 'crockery')



Christmas trees

Plastic



Bicycles

Donated to Brainwave Bikes



Empty paint tins

Lids removed



Hot water systems

Empty of water and maximum weight of 55kgs



Items with the green recycling symbol will be recycled



Items with the red garbage symbol are sent to landfill

Composting is an inexpensive way to turn organic waste into fertiliser for your garden, while reducing emissions and waste sent to landfill.

Options to choose from include Bokashi Buckets, worm farms, compost bins and more. Choosing the right system for you will depend on what materials and space you have.

- Buy items in bulk, with minimal packaging that is reusable or recyclable.
- Donate or sell used goods that are in good condition.
- Buy quality items that are going to last.
- Plan your meals to reduce food waste.
- Grow your own food, such as fruit, vegetables and herbs.
- Invest in reusable items e.g. bees wax wraps, drink bottle and coffee cup or reuse what you have, such as glass jars for storage.
- Compost your organic waste at home or use the food and garden organics service.





Asbestos

Electronic waste (E-waste)

E-waste is any unwanted item with a plug, battery or cord. E-waste must not go in your bins.

Large items can be recycled for free at our Recycling and Waste Centre.

Small items such as cords, computer devices and mobile phones, can be recycled at specified drop-off points. Visit recyclemate.com.au to find your closest point.



Batteries

Accepted for free at the hubs at our Customer Service Centres and at B-cycle drop-off points. Visit the **Recycle Mate** app or website to find your nearest location.



Light globes

Light globes can be recycled at our Recycling and Waste Centre, the hubs at our Customer Service Centres, and at Vermont South Library.

Fluorescent lights are accepted at our Recycling and Waste Centre.



Household chemicals

Paint (up to 100 litres) can be recycled for free at our Recycling and Waste Centre.

Dispose of chemicals safely through Sustainability Victoria's free **Detox Your Home** drop off events or sites.

X-Rays

Small quantities can be recycled at our Recycling and Waste Centre, the hubs at our Customer Service Centres, and at Vermont South Library.
