#### Operational

- As directed, undertake the installation of lighting or audio equipment for theatrical productions.
- Operate lighting, sound, stage and audio-visual equipment as required from bumpin, operations during performance and bump-out.
- As directed, undertake first line maintenance and cleaning of equipment or venue facilities.
- · Multi-tasking across all technical work areas.
- Liaise with and take direction from Bar and Front of House Supervisor to ensure the safe and successful operation of any performance.
- Conduct inventory checks of equipment and consumable stock, as directed.
- Account for the WPAC's assets and equipment.
- · Evening and weekend work will be required.

#### Safety & Emergency Management

- Maximise the safe and efficient use of technical equipment being set-up for theatrical productions ensuring Council's OH&S policy and safe procedures are practiced at all times.
- During shifts, act as a Warden for emergencies.
